Subject: Revised guidelines for re-issuance of Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) cards.

Government of India has revised instructions/guidelines on "Re-issuance of OCI cards due to Issuance of new foreign passports to OCI cardholders.

- i. Mandatory requirement of re-issuance of an OCI card each time a new passport is issued to a foreigner upto 20 years of age and once after completing 50 years of age is dispensed with.
  - ii. OCI cardholder is required to get the OCI card re-issued only once when a new passport is issued after completing 20 years of age so as to capture his/her facial features.
- iii. OCI cardholder is required to **upload ONLINE** a copy of the **new passport and a latest photo each time** a new passport is issued upto 20 years of age and **once** after completing 50 years of age. The uploading of these documents on the OCI portal may be done within **three months** of receipt of the new passport. The service will be provided on **Gratis** [no cost/free] basis.
- iv. Foreign Spouse of an Indian Citizen or spouse of foreign origin of an OCI cardholder are required to upload a copy of the **new passport and also a latest photo**ONLINE each time a new passport is issued <u>along with a declaration on subsisting</u>

  of marriage, copy of the Indian passport of the Indian spouse/passport & OCI card of the OCI cardholder spouse.
- 2. Necessary changes to upload documents in the OCI portal to facilitate above services to OCI cardholders will be done soon.
- 3. In the meanwhile, the <u>timeline for re-issuance of OCI card in respect of OCI cardholders has been extended till 31 December, 2021.</u> The OCI card holders travelling on the strength of their existing OCI card bearing old passport number are not required to carry their old passport.
