ADDENDUM TO NOTICE INVITING BIDS

Dated- May 03, 2019

This is in reference to the 'Notice inviting bids' for installation and maintenance of solar power system in India House (Residence of Consul General of India, Cape Town) - No. 5 Avenue Beaumont, Constantia, Cape Town, floated by the Consulate General of India on April 16, 2019.

2. The following addendum/clarification to the notice may be noted:
 - i. The objective behind this project is to **NOT** to go off-grid. The property will still be drawing power from ESKOM after installation of solar power system. The project is intended to supplement existing power requirements with solar power.
 - ii. In view of recurrent power outages as witnessed in past few months in Cape Town, the bid may also include provision for a power back up for at least 4 hours at a single stretch. This power back up will be used to run only essential items like lighting, kitchen equipment, alarm systems, etc.
 - iii. The proposed system may include provision to utilize solar power for 1-2 geysers. This could be either through solar panels or installation of solar water heaters, whatever is a more cost effective and reliable solution.

3. In view of this addendum and requests from a few prospective bidders, the deadline for submission of bids has been extended to Monday, May 27, 2019. The date of opening of Technical Bids (Participant bidders or their representative may wish to be present) will be Wednesday, May 29, 2019 at 1200 hrs at the Consulate General of India, Cape Town.
